CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman, John Nugent, called the public hearing to order on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Members of the Board of Commissioners present were Commissioners Kylon Fort and Ronnie Gaskins. Commissioners Jimmy Parker and Pixie Harrod were absent.

Commissioner Ronnie Gaskins made a motion to move into public hearing, seconded by Commissioner Kylon Fort. County Administrator stated that the public hearing is for a proposed tax increase. The Board of Commissioners is considering keeping the millage rate the same and not rolling it back. The current millage rate is 16.18 mils and without rolling it back will bring an approximate amount of \$178,293.00 to Berrien County. The floor was opened for public comment. Ms. Elaine Landy asked for clarification. Chief Tax Assessor Greg Nimmo explained the millage and stated that if nothing has changed with your property, you should not see much of a difference. This will be more for commercial properties, rentals, new home sales, these will see the increase. Commissioner Ronnie Gaskins stated that a home that is valued at \$100,000 will see an increase of approximately \$5.60. Ms. Landy thanked Greg Nimmo for the clarification. There were no other comments.
