A. WEIGHT SCALE ACQUISITION – SOLID WASTE – Administration received a request to purchase scales for the solid waste transfer site. Two quotes were provided from South Georgia Scales, Inc. New scales in the amount of \$80,565.00 or used scales for \$68,380.00. County Administrator, Brenda Ferrell, stated that we can apply for a reimbursable grant through Deep South Solid Waste and it can be funded through the Solid Waste Fund. Commissioner Jimmy Parker made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Pixie Harrod.



ADJOURN


